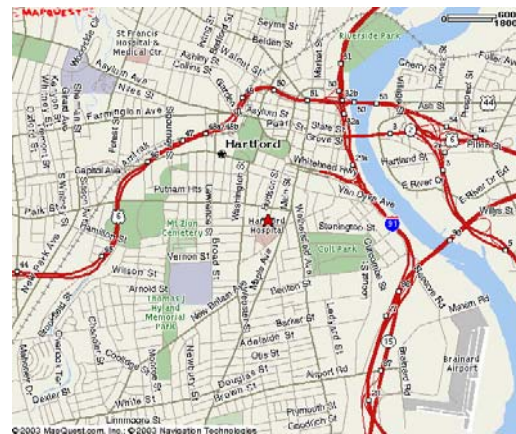

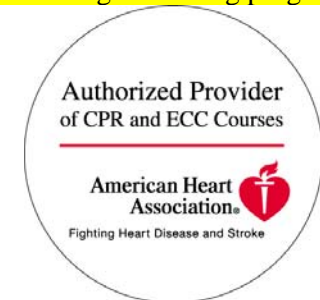
Upon completing this program, the student will be eligible to be mentored as an ACLS Instructor for the American Heart Association
