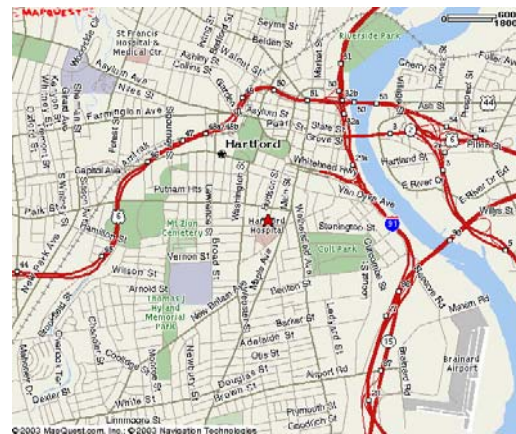

1. Teach in 2 classes for each of the last 2 years (4 classes total)
2. Be monitored while teaching
3. Demonstrate their provider (CPR) skills
4. Take and pass the written exam for Healthcare Providers with a 90% or better
5. Attend an Instructor Update

This program will meet ALL of these requirements, EXCEPT for #1, the teaching requirement.
